And washed it off in soapy foam.

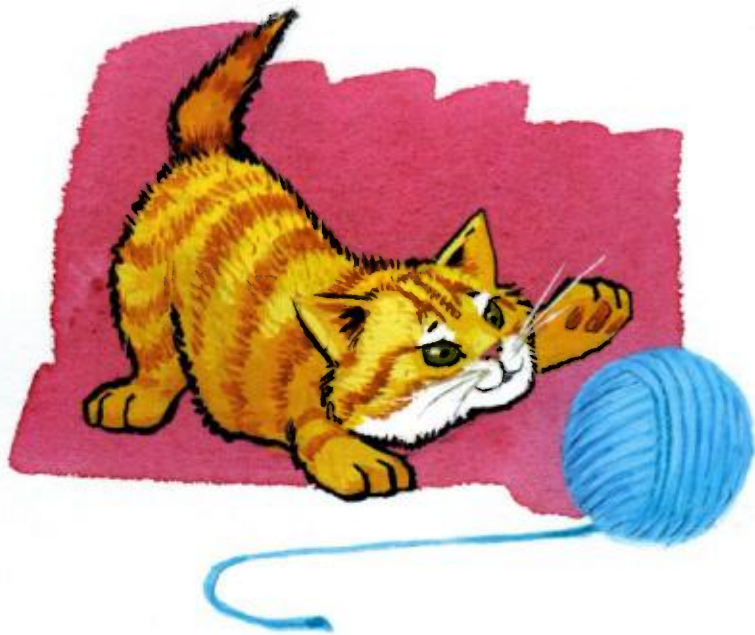


“He’s cute,” she said, “but I’m no whiz.
