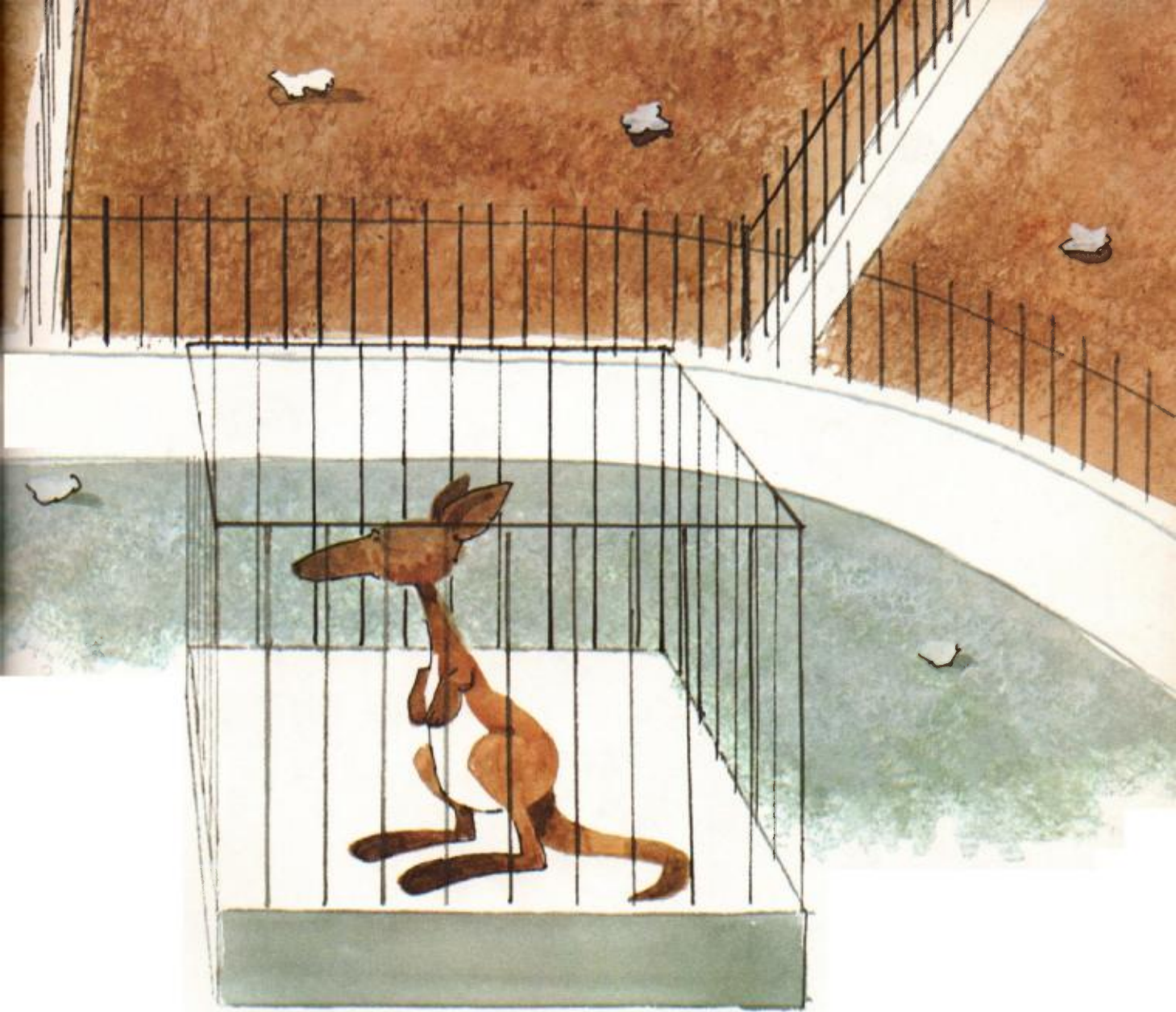




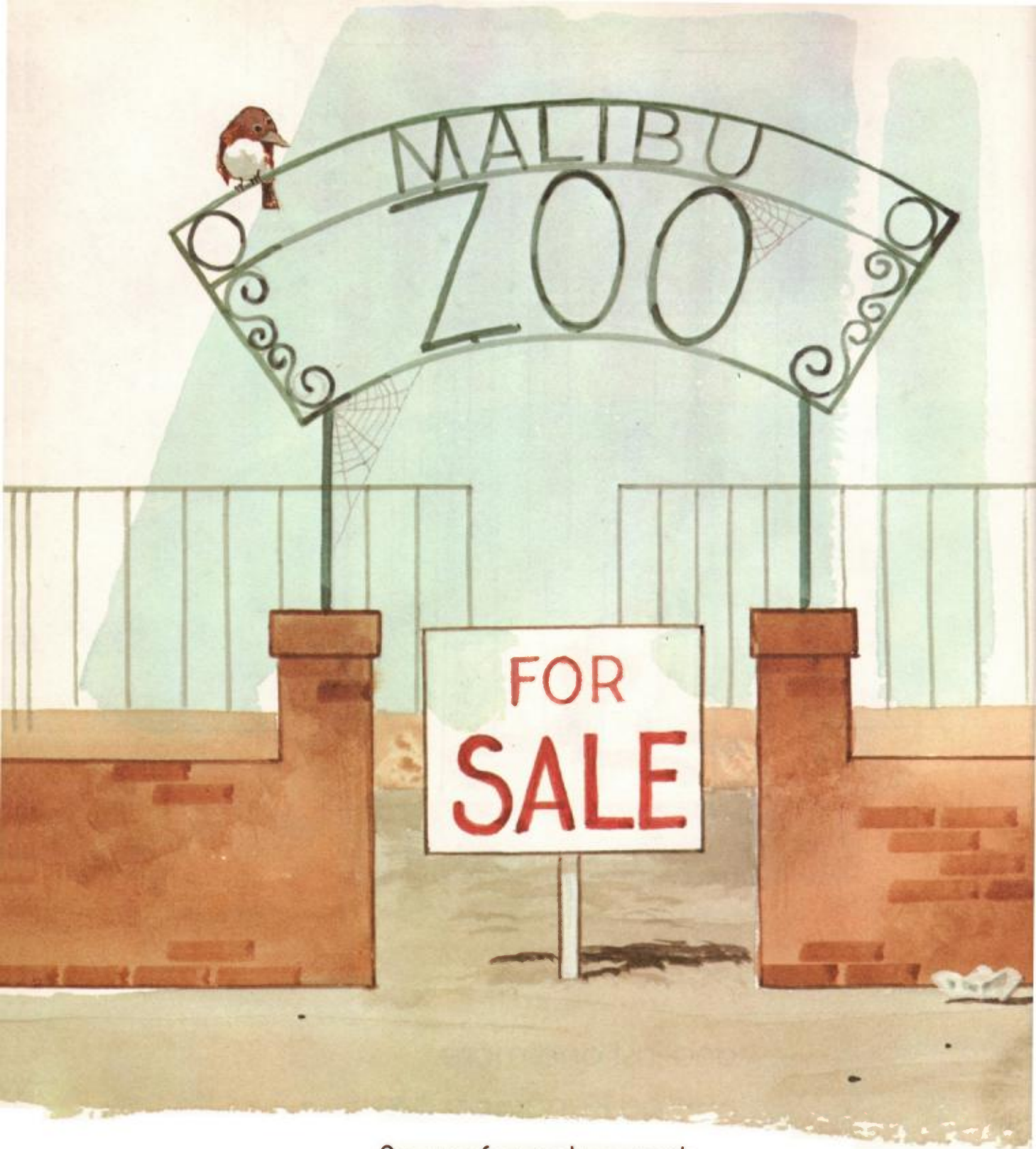
No one went to the Malibu Zoo.
