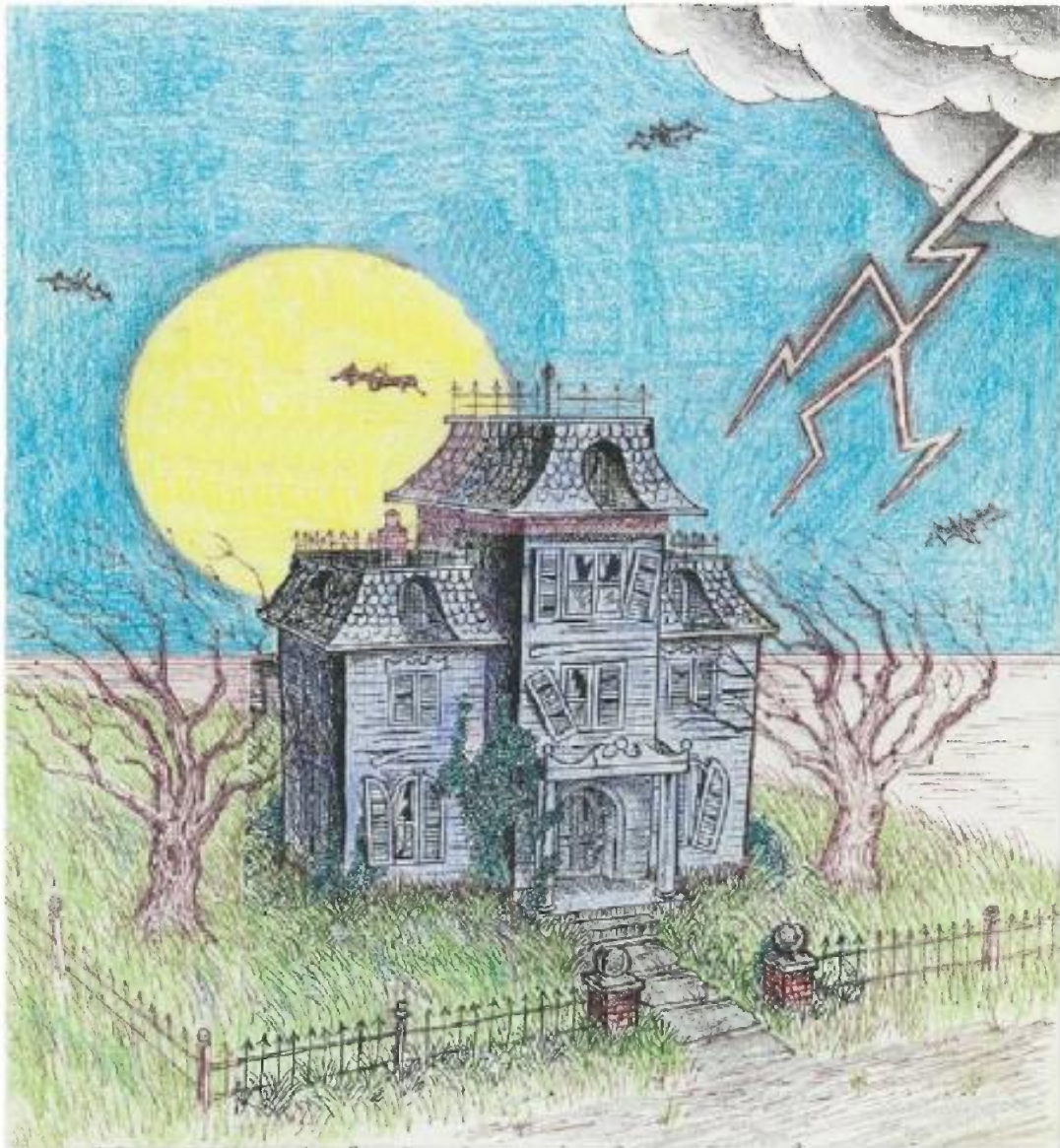

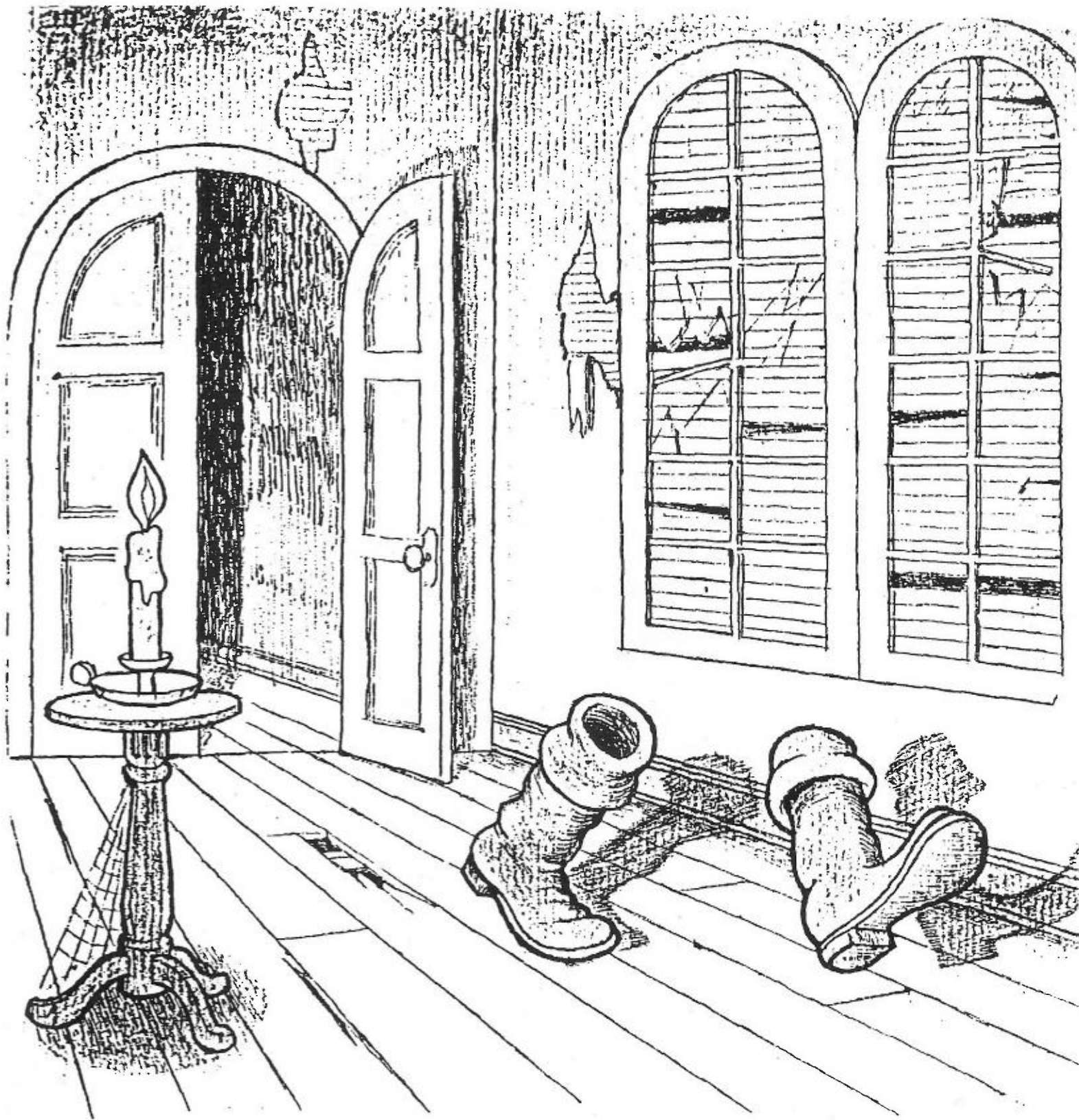

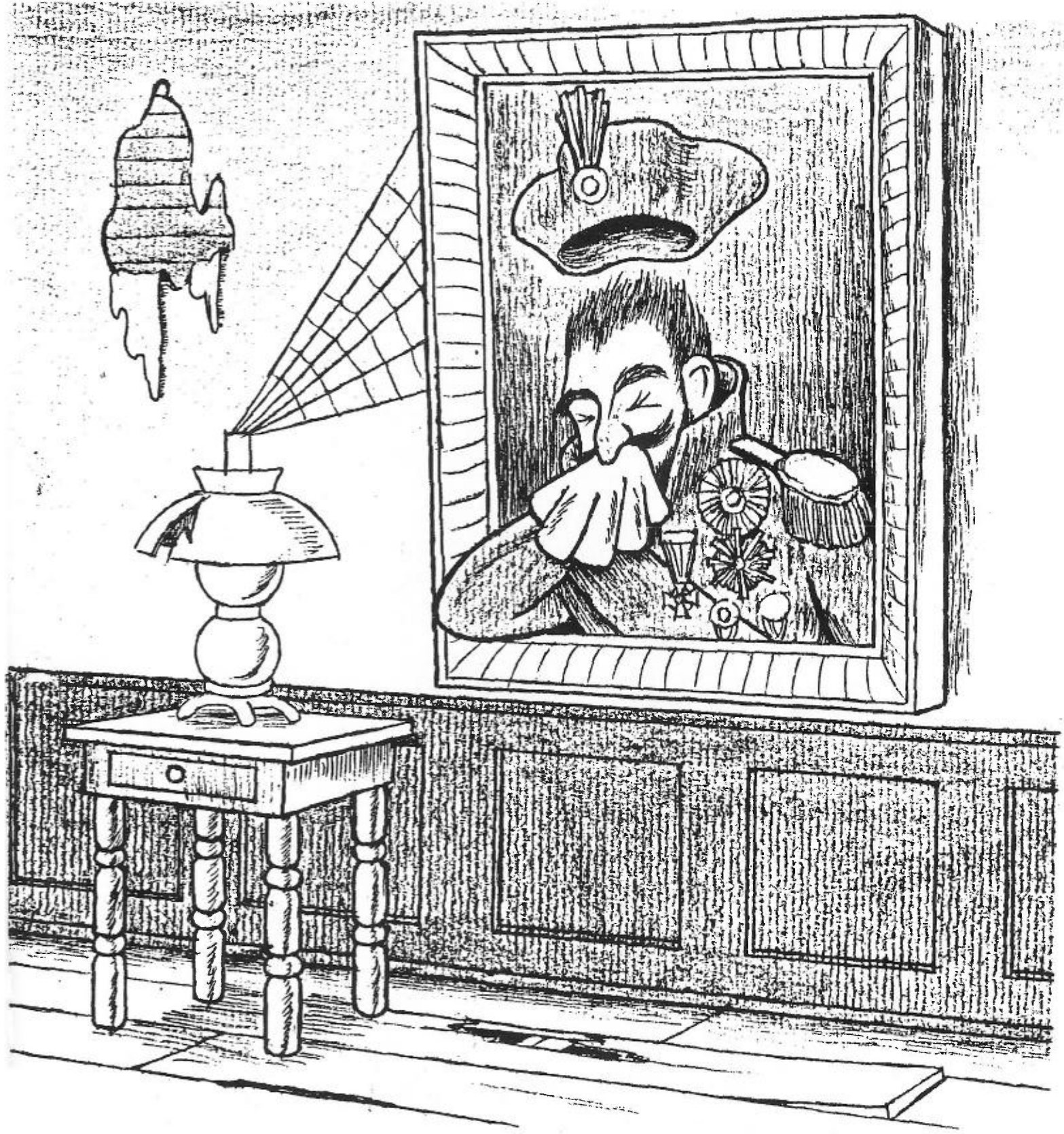
*I want you to know before we start

It's YOUR house to haunt, anyway you please!

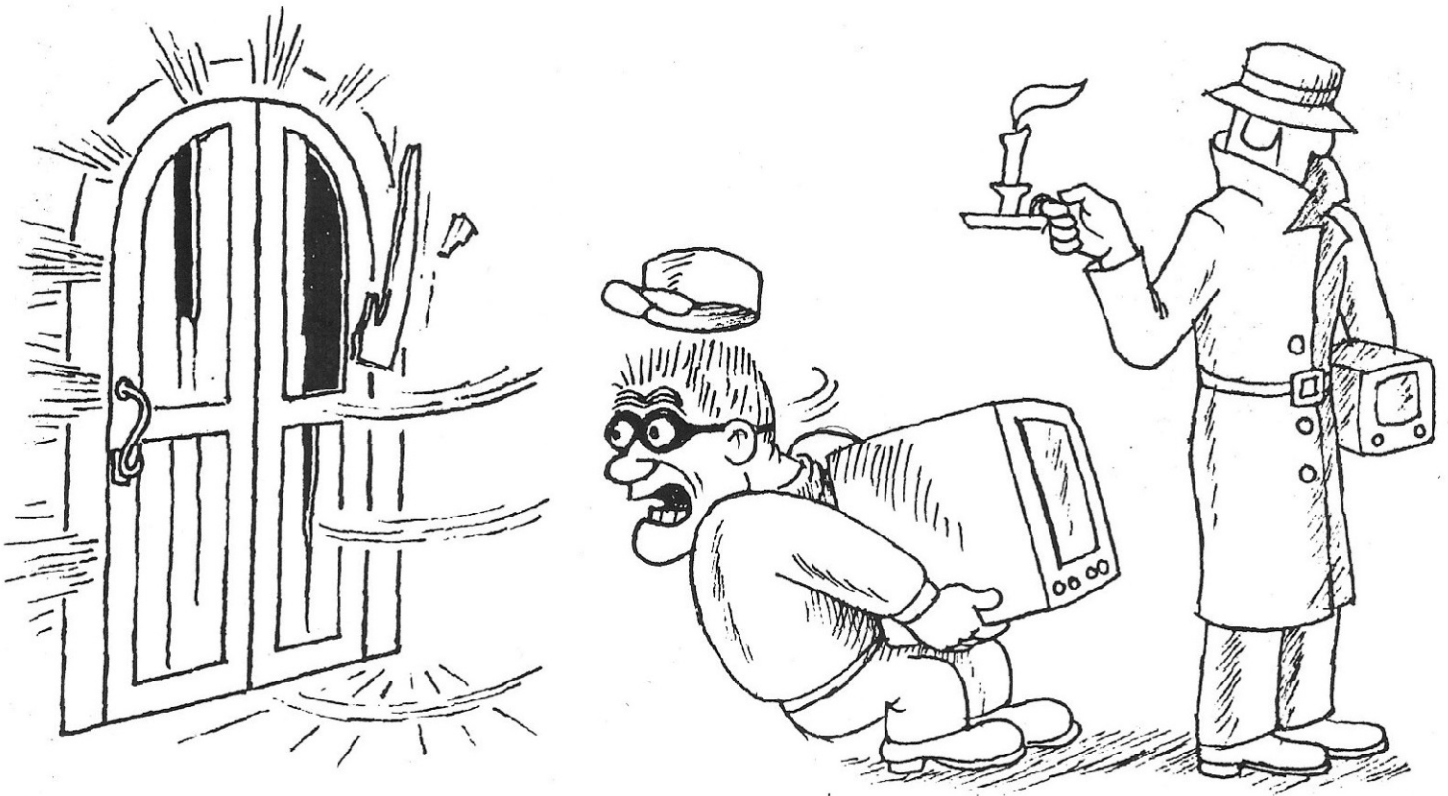


But wait! Who are those men prowling outside?
